Carafes

How nice it is to sit at the table and have some carafes filled with wine. I like those traditional ceramic pitchers, decorated with flowers pictures and funny local dialect proverbs ... they give us a sense of sincerity. You can see many in bars ... the oldest have perfect outlines: perfect proportions, diameters, efficient curves. They were handmade at the potter's wheel, one by one, with astounding precision, just like they all came from the same mould. Wine poured out of a ceramic carafe has a distinguished charm and makes the gathering more spontaneous.

Here, I reinterpreted rural traditional carafes and enriched them with the "colombino" or "pallini" techniques particular to "Tuttoattaccato" products, with white, gold and silver finish. Not a novelty on the well established old shapes of centuries ago, but a new look. I offer cylindrical carafes with and without handles, always with an easy grip. They remind us of the shape of a typical old inn pitcher "one litre", "litro da osteria" as they were once called.
